

DOs and DONTs for Officials in the Containment Zone

- The Order No 10870/BMC dated 02/04/2020 issued describes the details of the Containment Zones along-with facility provided thereon.
- All the Entry/Exit points of the containment zones have been barricaded and to be guarded by Police to check and prevent in and out of general public.
- In no case the inhabitants within the containment zone should move out except for emergent health requirements for which special medical arrangement will be made by Health Dept and BMC.
- The Sanitation/Disinfection arrangement will be done by BMC on daily basis. The Bonafide Sanitation/Disinfection Staffs will be issued with special duty/Coordination passes from BMC who may be allowed inside and move out from the containment zone.
- For distribution of Essentials, mobile vans will be engaged. The vehicles will be given special passes to move in and out who may be allowed.
- For convenience a single entry point may be made to move inside the containment zone by all concerned and the same entry may be made the only exit point for smooth enforcement and checking. The Personnel/Vehicles may be allowed inside on production of valid passes to be issued by BMC
