**ORDER**

The Govt of Odisha in Health & Family Welfare department in their letter No 8456 dated 28-03-2020 of Director of Health Services and order No 11759 dated 24-06-2020 of DMET have issued comprehensive guidelines for Private hospitals & Nursing Homes to deal with COVID-19 cases in case they are detected in course of their treatment, their care, shifting to designated COVID hospital. The guidelines also suggest the preparatory work, training and orientations that is needed for the health care workers for treating COVID patients.

In order to streamline the treatment and shifting of patients/critically ill patients and facilitate their movement to designated COVID hospitals, the following arrangement is hereby made for patients who have been diagnosed with COVID-19 in course of their treatment at private hospital/nursing home within BMC jurisdiction for strict adherence.

1. As soon as a positive case is detected in any private hospital/Nursing home, a copy of detail case history/treatment record along with latest patient condition and specific opinion regarding the stability and transportability of the patient of the chief treating doctor will be immediately forwarded to the ADUPHO, Bhubaneswar in his mail ID: [cpmunhmbbsr1@gmail.com](mailto:cpmunhmbbsr1@gmail.com) along with a request letter for such shifting. The hospital authority shall also inform the ADUPHO , Bhubaneswar telephonically about such request.
2. Upon receipt of the details of the positive case, an expert team consists of the following Doctors will examine the case and recommend their findings to Commissioner BMC for shifting the patient to designated COVID hospital or otherwise.
  - a. Addl DMET or his representative(must be a qualified doctor)
  - b. Dr C V S N Rao, ADUPHO, Bhubaneswar
  - c. Dr Basanta Ku Mishra, Health Officer, BMC, Bhubaneswar
3. As soon as decision is taken for shifting, the hospital authority will be informed of such shifting with an intimation to the referred COVID hospital by BMC.
4. Till such time the hospital authority shall ensure continuance of specialized treatment of the patient in isolation by following guidelines of DHS vide letter No 8456 dated 28-03-2020.
5. In no case the private hospital/Nursing Home authority shall shift the patient without observing the above procedure.
