Sub: Monitoring the attendance of Doctors/Paramedics in the DCHs

Sir,

I am to invite a reference on the subject cited above and inform that in COVID hospitals the timely presence of Doctors and paramedics are of paramount importance for effective treatment of patients. The mere presence of a doctor near the patient have a great psychological advantage for the patient and hence it is essential that doctors should visit the patients more often in a day to ascertain the health condition of the patient. This will also help timely shifting of patient from General to ICU for critical care intervention which will ultimately result in timely cure of the in-patients and further decrease in fatality rate.

It is therefore needed that strict monitoring of the attendance be checked for the doctors and paramedics for treatment of positive patients. Initially the scale of requirement and the availability may be obtained beforehand for your record. The daily/weekly advanced duty schedule may also be obtained for cross checking. Surprise check may be conducted outside the entry of the COVID Hospital at least two times in a week especially half and hour before the shift changing time up to half an hour beyond the shift changing time. This will give a figure of the attendance vis a vis the advanced duty schedule.

The weekly surprise check may be submitted in the form of a report to the undersigned for record and review.

This may be treated as **EXTREMELY IMPORTANT AND URGENT**.
