**ORDER PASSED BY SECRETARY, BDA ON 25.10.23 IN COMPLIANCE TO
THE ORDER DTD. 02.09.2023 OF THE HON'BLE HIGH COURT IN W.P.(C)
No. 28492 OF 2023**

This is regarding compliance of the order dtd. 02.09.2023 in WP(C) No. 28491 of 2023 filed by Arupananda Swain. Hon'ble High Court disposed of the above writ petition on 02.09.2023. The relevant portion of the order is as follows:-

"This Court directs the Secretary, BDA to give a lawful disposal to such application of the petitioner also involving the petitioner within a period of one & half months from the date of communication of a copy of this order by the petitioner".

In compliance to the above order, notice was issued to the petitioner and heard the petitioner Sri Arupananda Swain. But he refused sign in the attendance sheet. Fact of the case in sort is that the petitioner was earning his livelihood by running a shop in the Golai Chhak at Baramunda in Bhubaneswar Town, which is a Govt. land. The Shop of the petitioner was demolished in lieu of the renovation work of Baramunda Bus Stand to ISBT, which is a World Class Project. The petitioner filed this writ with a prayer to provide a shop room inside of ISBT to compensate the demolition of his shop.

As a matter of principle, the allotment of shops inside the ISBT are being made in favour of the allottees of shops previously allotted by OSRTC inside Baramunda Bus Stand. The petitioner was not a allottee inside the Baramunda Bus Stand under OSRTC, so he is not eligible to get a shop room inside ISBT. However, considering the plight of the petitioner, Commissioner, BMC is requested to give priority in providing a shop in the vending zone located nearby Baramunda Bus Stand in future. As such, the application of the petitioner stands disposed of.

Intimate the petitioner accordingly.
