Sheds provide shelter and relaxation spaces, and gates welcome visitors with architectural grace. The innovative tensile shed showcases contemporary design and versatility. E. TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. Eligibility Criteria

- a. The bidder should be a legal entity such as Company/ Limited Firms/ Proprietorship Firm/ Private Limited Firm/ rules in India. (Copies of Incorporation/Registration certificate to be enclosed).
- b. The bidder must have successfully executed a minimum of three work of value not less than INR 30 Lakhs involving the supply of similar or higher rated to any Central/State Government, PSU, ULBS, Private companies, etc., during the last 3 years in India prior to the date of issuing this RFP. (Copies of Work Orders/Completion Certificates are to be submitted for verification).
- c. The bidder should have not been debarred/ blacklisted by any Central / State government department / public sector undertaking / other government entities or local body in last 05 years in India prior to the date of issue of this RFP. (Undertaking to be submitted on non-judicial stamp paper).
- d. The bidder should have a strong team of quality engineers (minimum 3 Engineers) capable of delivering high-quality design and installation work. (Please provide details of the engineering expertise of payroll employees.)

- e. Joint Venture/ Consortium not allowed.
- f. Conditional proposals submitted by the bidder shall be canceled.
- g. The bidder should have valid PAN Card and GST registration certificate.
- h. A copy of all work order/Experience certificate must be provided.

2. Financial Criteria:

- a. The bidder should have minimum annual average turnover in similar work of Rs 100.00 Lakhs during the last 03 (three) Financial Years i.e. FY 2020-21, FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-23 (Turnover certificate duly certified by CA and copies of ITR, Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account Statement to be submitted).
- b. The bidder should have Valid PAN Card
- c. The bidder should have a Valid GST Certificate.

4. Scope of Work

The selected implementing agency or firm will be expected to execute the following tasks as scope of work for all structural projects.

- i. The Outdoor Gazebo Design, supply, fabrication, and erection of an outdoor gazebo within the park premises.
- ii. The gazebo should provide quality seating arrangements and blend harmoniously with the natural surroundings.
- iii. Ensure that the gazebo structure is durable, weather-resistant, and aesthetically pleasing.
- iv. Ensure compliance with safety standards and structural integrity requirements.
- v. The shed Design, supply, fabrication, and erection of the shed in front of park premises to provide shelter and relaxation space for visitors.
- vi. The shed design should prioritize functionality, aesthetics, and durability to withstand varying weather conditions and ensure long-term usability.
- vii. The bidder must possess appropriate crane equipment for the safe and efficient installation

- of the shed.
- viii. All aspects of shed construction, including material selection, welding, and assembly, should adhere strictly to Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) standards to ensure structural integrity and safety. The specifications for welding /joints in the structures should be as per standard codal provisions ISO 15610:2023 and IS816:1969.
- ix. Construction of a structural bridge to enhance the park's aesthetics and facilitate visitor movement.
- x. The bridge should be designed to complement the park's landscape and provide a safe and accessible pathway as per the drawing.
- xi. Implementation of quality control measures during welding processes to meet load-bearing requirements and withstand environmental stresses.
- xii. Compliance with safety standards and regulations throughout the erection process, including the use of proper lifting techniques, securing of components, and adherence to site safety protocols.
- xiii. Provision of detailed engineering drawings and documentation outlining the structural specifications, material properties, and welding procedures to be employed in shed construction.
- xiv. Collaboration with BMC authorities and stakeholders to ensure that the gate design meets functional requirements, accessibility standards, and aesthetic preferences.
- xv. The Tensile Shed Collaborate with BMC and relevant stakeholders to develop detailed design drawings and specifications for the tensile shed, ensuring alignment with aesthetic, functional, and safety requirements.
- xvi. Conduct structural analysis and engineering calculations to determine the optimal design configuration, including load-bearing capacity, wind resistance, and material selection.
- xvii. Ensure that the tensile shed design complies with all technical specifications outlined in the RFP, including dimensions, shape, and material properties.
- xviii. Material should be high-quality materials as per the tender specifications.
- xix. Fabricate steel frames and supporting structures with precision and attention to detail, ensuring dimensional accuracy and structural integrity.
- xx. Employ advanced fabrication techniques, such as welding, cutting, and bending, to produce components that meet specified tolerances and quality standards.
- xxi. Manufacture fabric membranes using state-of-the-art techniques, including cutting, welding, and sealing, to achieve the desired tensile strength, flexibility, and longevity.
- xxii. Coordinate logistics and scheduling to facilitate the timely delivery (30 days) and installation of the tensile shed components at the designated park site.
- xxiii. Deploy skilled labor and specialized equipment, including tensioning devices and lifting machinery, to ensure safe and efficient erection of the tensile structure.
- xxiv. Adhere to stringent safety protocols and industry best practices during installation activities, including proper anchoring, tensioning, and bracing of the fabric membranes and support structures.
- xxv. Conduct thorough quality inspections and testing to verify the integrity and stability of the tensile shed upon completion of installation.
- xxvi. designed to incentivize consistent excellence in project execution, maintenance, and adherence to quality standards throughout the contract period, ensuring the long-term durability and functionality of the constructed structures.
- xxvii. The gate Design, supply, fabrication, and erection of an aesthetically pleasing gate at the


- park entrance to create an inviting ambiance for visitors.
- xxviii. The gate design should blend harmoniously with the park's surroundings while reflecting the cultural and architectural heritage of Bhubaneswar.
- xxix. The bidder must possess appropriate crane equipment for the safe and precise installation of the gate.
- xxx. All welding activities associated with gate fabrication and erection must comply with BIS standards, ensuring the structural integrity and load-bearing capacity of the gate. The specifications for welding /joints in the structures should be as per standard codal provisions ISO 15610:2023 and IS816:1969.










GAZEBO TOP VIEW








Structure-A Composite Structural Canopy at Entranance



F. INFORMATION TO BIDDERS

1. Cost of Document

The bidder is required to submit document cost along with the proposal amounting to Rs.11,800/-(Rupee Eleven thousand Eight Hundred Only) in the form of Demand Draft only drawn from any Scheduled Commercial Bank in India in favor of "Commissioner, Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation" payable at Bhubaneswar.

Any proposal not accompanied by tender document cost shall be summarily rejected.

2. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

EMD in shape of Demand Draft from any scheduled commercial bank in favour of **Commissioner**, **Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation** payable at **Bhubaneswar** for 40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand Only) is to be furnished by the bidder along with the Technical Bid. Bid without the requisite EMD shall be treated as non-responsive and rejected. No adjustment of EMD with respect to other works previously lying with the BMC is allowed. Unsuccessful bidder's EMD will be discharged / returned within 90 days from the date of execution of the agreement between BMC and the selected Agency. No interest will be paid on EMD.

Exemption from Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) is extended to Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSME) units. This measure aims to support and encourage participation from MSMEs in procurement processes by alleviating financial burdens typically associated with EMD requirements, thereby fostering greater inclusivity and competitiveness within government contracts and tenders.

3. Performance Security Deposit (PSD)

The selected bidder, for due and faithful performance of its obligations under the contract, shall be required to provide a "Performance Security" for an amount equal to 10% of total contract value in the form of a 'Bank Guarantee' / 'Demand Draft' issued from any Scheduled Commercial Bank in India drawn in favour of "Commissioner, Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation" payable at Bhubaneswar, to Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation prior to signing of Agreement. The performance security shall remain valid till the end of the contract period and beyond 3 months from the contract's expiry period. No interest whatsoever should be paid on the amount of Performance Security deposited by the agency.

4. Maintenance and Defect Liability Period (DLP):

Maintenance Responsibility:

- a. The selected bidder shall be responsible for the proper maintenance and care of all newly constructed structures, including but not limited to gazebos, sheds, and tensile structures, for a period of one year from the date of project completion.
- Maintenance activities shall encompass routine inspections, cleaning, repairs, and necessary adjustments to ensure the structural integrity, functionality, and aesthetic appeal of the installed structures.

Defect Liability Period (DLP):

- c. The Defect Liability Period (DLP) for all constructed works shall be One year from the date of project completion.
- d. During the DLP, the supplier shall be responsible for addressing any defects, faults, or deficiencies

in materials, workmanship, or construction that may arise, excluding those resulting from force majeure events.

- e. The supplier shall promptly rectify any defects or issues identified during the DLP at no additional cost to Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation (BMC).
- f. Throughout the DLP, the supplier shall ensure the durability and color retention of all constructed structures, employing suitable maintenance practices and protective treatments as necessary.
- g. Measures shall be taken to prevent fading, corrosion, degradation, or any other forms of deterioration that may compromise the appearance or functionality of the structures.

5. Force Majeure Exclusion:

The maintenance obligations outlined herein shall exclude damages or failures resulting from force majeure events, including natural disasters, acts of war, civil disturbances, or any other unforeseeable circumstances beyond the control of the supplier.

In the event of force majeure, the supplier shall cooperate with BMC to assess and mitigate damages to the extent feasible within the limitations of the contractual agreement.

6. Terms and Payment:

Payment for the structural project will be disbursed by BMC to the selected agency ("L1" bidder) upon satisfactory completion of designated milestones. The payment terms are structured as follows:

Upon successful completion of the initial phase, 80% of the total payment will be released. This payment will be authorized following a comprehensive inspection of the completed structures by designated BMC officials.

The remaining 20% of the total payment will be released, contingent upon the satisfactory performance of the constructed structures and adherence to contractual terms and conditions and after certified by the responsible officials.

The PBG amount will be release after successfully completion of the DLP period.

7. Price Escalation:

In the event of modifications resulting as per site conditions drawing of the work may change, the contractor will receive escalation payment as per revised drawing. Invoicing will be carried out after the completion of the project with due approval from the Authority, ensuring accurate compensation for any additional work performed due to unforeseen circumstances encountered during construction.

8. Arbitration:

In case of any dispute arising out of or connected with or incidental to this contract. The dispute will be referred to an arbitrator appointed by the Commissioner BMC, Bhubaneswar. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both parties. The arbitration proceedings will be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration and Reconciliation Act, 1996.
